Hear and experience the unique perspectives of grassroots Cuban women who experience and organize to resolve issues that create an impact the well-being of women and their families.

**This delegation will intentionally include space for women's voices and women's work in diverse and interconnected arenas such as:**

- Engage with Martin Luther King Jr. Memorial Center's ecumenical network of Women leaders .
- Meet with community organizers and visit community projects focusing on health, art, and popular education.
- Visit sustainable agriculture projects and meet with women involve in urban and rural farming, permaculture and environmental protection.
- Learn about campaigns against homophobia and promoting rights for transgendered people.
- Discuss the role of women in Cuban faith communities with female religious leaders from different backgrounds.
- Learn about the Cuban public health system and preventative medicine.
- Learn about issues of poverty, female headed households, domestic violence, sexual assault, the sex industry from women who have direct experience supporting other women.
- Hear the hopes and dreams of Cuban women for themselves, their families and our planet.

Applications: Due by December 19, 2013 with a \$150 deposit. Total due January 19, 2014

Cost: \$1,600 plus airfare to Havana and a \$75 visa fee. This includes all meals, accommodations, facilitation, translation, and transportation in Cuba. Your fee also covers an orientation/training session, and extensive reading materials and action tools distributed both before and after the delegation.
